ORDINANCE NO. 317 Series of 2019

"AN ORDINANCE MANDATING ALL MOTORCYCLE RIDERS TO WEAR PROTECTIVE MOTORCYCLE HELMETS WHILE DRIVING WITHIN THE ROADS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ROSARIO, CAVITE"

WHEREAS, Congress has passed Republic Act No. 10054 otherwise known as "Motorcycle Helmet Act of 2009" and pursuant to this law, it is the duty of the Local Government to secure and safeguard its citizeners, particularly drivers of motorcycle and back riders, from the ruinous and extremely injurious effects of fatal or life-threatening accidents and crashes. Towards this end, it shall pursue a more proactive and preventive approach to secure the safety of motorists, their backriders at all times through the mandatory enforcement of the use of standard protective motorcycle helmet;

WHEREFORE, it is necessary to pass an ordinance to strictly enforce Republic Act No. 10054:

THUS, BE IT ENACTED THAT,

Section 1. Coverage. All motorcycle riders, including drivers and back riders, shall at all times wear standard protective motorcycle helmets while driving, in any type of roads and highway within the Municipality of Rosario, Cavite.

Section 2. *Penalties*. Any person caught not wearing the standard protective motorcycle helmet in violation of this Ordinance shall be punished with a fine of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) for the first offense; One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) for the second offense; Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) for the third offense plus confiscation of the driver's license.

Section 3. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
